

Volunteer Drivers needed in the GTA

Since the start of the pandemic, non-profit organizations have seen a significant decline in volunteer drivers. These volunteers provide delivery and transportation support for programs that bring essential goods and services to the most vulnerable people in our communities. Volunteer drivers are the most needed volunteer role in Toronto, York and Peel regions.

Non-profits and local community-led groups need drivers who:

- Can dedicate 3–6 hours per week
- Have access to a car and a valid G license
- Are willing to complete a driving record check

When deciding to become a Volunteer Driver, you should consider:

- When you are available and how long you can commit
- Your comfort level interacting with seniors and vulnerable people
- Additional tasks you are willing to do (e.g. sorting, packing, lifting)
